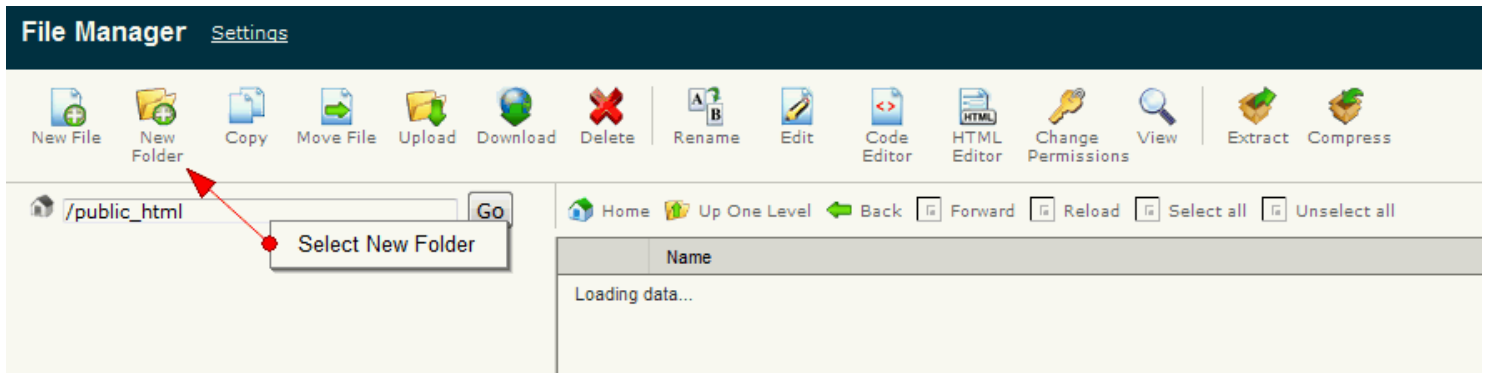
2. Click on "File Manager".

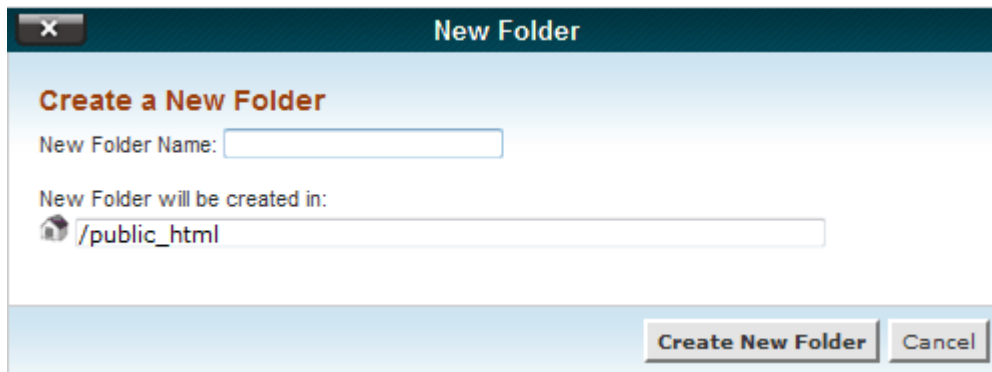

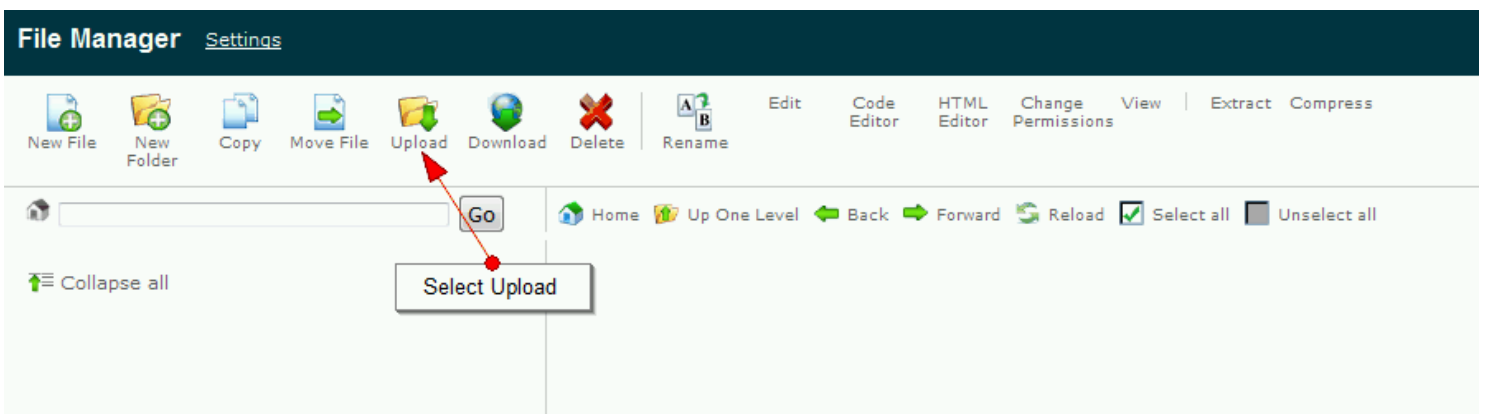
3. If you need a folder (some web designers place images or files in different folders on their domain) select “New Folder”.
